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Key Responsibilities

Purpose

- develop a thorough understanding of the academic demands of Common Entrance and Scholarship examinations, where appropriate;

- ensure all pupils are making good progress; to identify those who are not, and put in reasonable support for them;
- assess progress and keep a record of assessment in order to make an informed judgement for regular assessment grades;
- play a part in ensuring that pupils have a broad offering of extra curricular music events and activities including practice for, and performance and supervision at, those events;

At Broomwood we believe that, together, our


